##### Awarding and/or Rejecting of Bids

There are no award or rejections of bids.

##### Introduction of Ordinances

There is one ordinance for introduction.

Ordinance 10-A amends the Lawrence Township Administrative Code entitled "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" by establishing a weight limit of four (4) tons on Fackler Road.

##### Adoption of Ordinances

There are no ordinances for adoption.

##### Resolutions

The agenda includes routine administrative authorizations as well as resolutions providing for refunds, bond releases and acceptances.

Resolution 18-B authorizes joint participation in an agreement with Dr. Robert Burchell of Rutgers University for preparation of a Fair Share Housing Analysis to be utilized in the Declaratory Judgement Action filed in the Superior Court of Mercer County regarding Lawrence Township's Affordable Housing obligation. Participation in the costs and results of his analysis will be shared through the Municipal Shared Services Defense Agreement. The cost is \$2,000. Funding is available from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

Resolution 18-D authorizes a "Chapter 159" resolution that amends the 2015 adopted municipal budget by anticipating \$5,000 and appropriating the same for expenses associated with the Safety Town Program. Bristol-Myers Squibb Company is contributing the funds for the children's safety program.

Resolution 18-E authorizes a professional services contract with Clarke Caton Hintz for the

developing of plans and specifications for the installation of fencing and landscaping along the south side of Colonial Lake. The amount of the contract is \$4,380.50. Funding is available from previously adopted capital improvement ordinances.

Resolution 18-F authorizes cancellation of aged Cash Bond Escrow balances for previously approved projects.

Resolution 18-I authorizes a professional services agreement with Priya Stephen, M.D. for the providing of pediatric clinic medical services. The amount of the contract is not to exceed \$2,500 at an hourly rate of \$110. Funding is available from the appropriation for Board of Health Other Expenses.
