Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Dale Robbins at 7:35pm.

MINUTES: The committee reviewed the regular monthly meeting minutes for September 8, 2009. A motion was made by Rich Krawczun and seconded by Dan Posluszny to approve the minutes as written. All were in favor.

OLD BUSINESS

HEALTH REPORT: Carol Chamberlain reported that next Tuesday, October 20th, 2009 from 2:30-3:00pm the Hepatitis B vaccines will be given at the Public Works facility. Bloodborne Pathogen training dates will be scheduled: one in the daytime and one in the evening. She also reported that the flu vaccines will be administered this Thursday, October 15th, 2009 from 1:30-3:30pm at the Municipal Building in the Lower Level Conference Room for anyone interested in receiving one. A list of active members will be comprised and distributed to the Chiefs for their review.

EMERGENCY APPARATUS REPORTS: Chief Rob Santello reported Snorkel 21 out of service at this time for a fuel line problem but should be back in service tomorrow. Lawrence Road and Lawrenceville Fire Companies reported all apparatus are in service at this time. Dan Posluszny reported Ambulance 129-3 is out of service.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE NEWSPAPER ARTICLES: Chief Posluszny reported that articles about Bicycle Safety and Halloween Safety have been posted on the Township website.

FIRE SERVICES STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMITTEE: Chief Rob Santello reported that the implementation of the per diem firefighters has been going well. There has been no further business conducted. The meetings will be scheduled again after the election.

PSAP SYSTEM: Chief Posluszny reviewed a set of plans for a PSAP location at the current Lawrence Police Department, if the funding is approved next year.

Wayside Lane to Route 206: Chief Posluszny reported that he will call and check on the status.

NEW BUSINESS

PARKING AT SCHOOLS DURING EVENTS: A matter of parking issues during school events was brought to the attention of the committee. It was decided that Dan Posluszny will investigate as to why there is no stopping or standing on the side of the road. It was also agreed upon that Dan Posluszny and Dale Robbins meet with Phil Meara of the Board of Education, with regard to the approval of the school system for the No Parking/Fire Lane ordinance to be implemented at the township schools for emergency access.

There were no plans to be reviewed by the committee at this time.

NEXT MEETING: The next scheduled meeting of the Public Safety Coordinating Committee will be held on Tuesday, November 10th, 2009 at 7:30pm in the Manager's Conference Room.
