**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Greg Puliti, Council Liaison; Richard Krawczun, Municipal Manager; Dale Robbins, Fire Marshal; Chief Dan Posluszny, Lawrence Township Police; Carol Chamberlain, Health Officer; Chief Mark Lenarski, Slackwood Fire Company; Chief Ray Nagy, Lawrenceville Fire Company; Jack Oakley, Emergency Management Coordinator; Kyle Collins, Community Representative and John Gladwell, Community Representative.

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Dale Robbins at 7:34pm.

**Minutes:** The regular monthly meeting minutes for September 14, 2010 were reviewed by the committee. A motion was made by Jack Oakley and seconded by Rich Krawczun to accept the minutes as written. All were in favor.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**HEALTH REPORT:** Health Officer, Carol Chamberlain reported that First Responder Forms are due to be returned. She also reported that there have been several Bloodborne Pathogen Training classes, and there are still several people who have not been trained. She distributed lists to the Chiefs of the members that have not received the training through the township or that training documentation from another source has not been presented. Carol also reported that copies of the Exposure Control Plan are available for anyone who needs a copy.

**EMERGENCY APPARATUS REPORTS:** Slackwood and Lawrenceville Fire Company reported all apparatus to be in service at this time. There was no report from the Lawrence Road Fire Company due to their absence. Jack Oakley reported that Ambulance 129-1 is currently out of service for an oil leak and Ambulance 129-4 is currently having the radios installed.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE NEWSPAPER ARTICLES:** Chief Dan Posluszny reported that there will be an article posted with regard to Halloween safety followed up by an article in November about shopping safety.

**PIT STOP LOCATION:** Rich Krawczun reported that Carol Chamberlain has been working with the DEP with regard to a list of residences in the affected areas, for a testing of their wells for possible contamination. Carol Chamberlain further reported that the full results of the environmental testing being done will be available at the

end of October. The affected area encompasses the gas station location to Eldridge Avenue.

**SLACKWOOD FIRE COMPANY REQUEST FOR NEW APPARATUS:** Chief Mark Lenarski reported that prior to the Public Safety Coordinating Committee meeting, the Apparatus/Fire Sub Committee had a demonstration of an aerial apparatus similar to what Slackwood Fire Company is requesting by Sutphen. He would like the sub committee to hold a meeting at 6:30pm prior to the November 9<sup>th</sup> Public Safety Advisory Committee meeting to discuss the specifications and request. Chief Lenarski provided the sub committee members with a copy of the specification for the aerial apparatus. A memorandum will be sent to the sub committee members to remind them of the scheduled meeting.

**NON-EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO C.O. ALARMS BY THE LAWRENCEVILLE FIRE CO.:** Chief Ray Nagy reported that the only C.O. alarms that the fire company has had recently have been true alarms. He will have more data to provide soon.

**CRAFT CLEANERS BUILDING:** Rich Krawczun reported that Tony had sent a notice of structural deficiencies to the owner of the property. It was also reported that there is a Federal EPA grant to study the entire town for brown sites. This was endorsed by the New Jersey DEP.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**BEAR SIGHTINGS:** Kyle Collins inquired about any further bear sightings in the Lawrence Township area. Chief Posluszny reported that there have been several calls over the past few weeks, but the bears are not dangerous and tend to walk away from humans once sighted.

There were no plans to be reviewed by the Public Safety Coordinating Committee at this time.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS/CORRESPONDENCE**

There was no further business to be discussed by the Public Safety Coordinating Committee at this time.
