OLD BUSINESS

HEALTH REPORT: Health Officer, Carol Chamberlain asked the Fire Chiefs to give her dates to have the Bloodborne Pathogen training in January, 2012.

EMERGENCY APPARATUS REPORTS: Slackwood Fire Company, Lawrence Road Fire Company and Lawrenceville Fire Company reported all apparatus was in service at this time. Chief Posluszny reported that all apparatus was in service for the Lawrence Township Emergency Services.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEDIA ARTICLES: Chief Posluszny reported that there had not been any articles recently published and that an article on shopping safety will be posted. If anyone has any ideas for future articles, they should contact Chief Posluszny regarding this matter.

NEW BUSINESS

STOP SIGN AT HERITAGE WAY AND ALLEGHENY AVENUE: John Gladwell reported that there continues to be a problem with vehicles running the stop sign at the intersection of Heritage Way and Allegheny Avenue, usually between the hours of 7:30-8:00am and 4:30-5:00pm. Chief Posluszny stated that he will make sure that the Police Department gives passing attention to this matter.

NEW TENANT AT 1530 BRUNSWICK AVENUE: Greg Puliti reported that there is a safety concern with the dropping off of people at the front door of this office location, due to it's proximity to the Brunswick Circle. Chief Posluszny stated that the Police Department will be giving passing attention to this matter.

CHANGE OF COMMAND FOR 2012 AT THE LAWRENCEVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY: Chief Ray Nagy announced that after serving the past five (5) years as Chief of the fire company, he has decided to step down from that position and that Gary Wasko will be the Chief of Lawrenceville Vol. Fire Company next year. Ray will be assuming responsibilities of the President of the fire company.

There were no plans to be reviewed by the Public Safety Coordinating Committee at this time.

OTHER BUSINESS/CORRESPONDENCE

CHANGE OF MEETING TIME: Rich Krawczun addressed the committee with regard to possibly changing the time of the meetings of the Public Safety Coordinating Committee to an earlier start time.
