Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Dale Robbins at 7:33pm.

Swearing in of Newly Appointed Members: Council Liaison, Greg Puliti gave the Oath of Office to Roseann Manghisi, returning member.

Minutes: The regular monthly meeting minutes for May 10, 2011 were reviewed by the committee. A motion was made by John Gladwell and seconded by Roseann Manghisi to accept the minutes as written. All were in favor.

OLD BUSINESS

HEALTH REPORT: Health Officer, Carol Chamberlain reported that a list was compiled with regard to the members that are still in need of Bloodborne Pathogen Training. If a member has received this training, a copy of the test and roster is necessary to receive credit for this training. Otherwise, training should be scheduled.

EMERGENCY APPARATUS REPORTS: Dale Robbins reported for the Slackwood and Lawrenceville Fire companies that all apparatus was in service at this time. Chief Shaun Dlabik reported that Telesquirt 22 is out of service at this time for a bad alternator. Chief Posluszny reported that all apparatus is in service at this time for Lawrence Township Emergency Medical Services.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEDIA ARTICLES: Chief Posluszny reported that an article about bicycle safety was forwarded, although it was not posted in the Lawrence Ledger. There will be an upcoming article about fireworks safety.

GREENFIELD AND NORTHBROOK: Chief Posluszny reported that a survey was conducted at this intersection. 612 vehicles were counted during the survey, approximately 380 vehicles were between (0 – 7 mph) and the remainder were surveyed to be driving over 7 mph. This could be part of the reason why they are not observing the stop signage. The Police Department will be doing enforcement at this intersection, and will be working on a solution.

SLACKWOOD FIRE COMPANY NEW APPARATUS REQUEST: In order for a decision to be made with regard to the replacement or refurbishment of the Snorkel at Slackwood Fire company, there have been a few other vendors at the Slackwood Firehouse to demonstrate apparatus.

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM: Roseann Manghisi reported that she is hearing a lot of very positive feedback on the township's new emergency notification system.

MATRIX CONSULTING REPORT: Kyle Collins inquired about the Matrix Consulting report. Rich Krawczun reported that this report will be available on July 5th, 2011.
