**REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMIT:** The speed limit will be reduced 5 mph on Route 206 from Brearley to Rider University. Carol Chamberlain suggested a press release once the signs are posted.

**PASSING ON RIGHT IN THE VICINITY OF THE LAWRENCE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL:** John Gladwell brought it to the attention of the committee that on several occasions, he has witnessed vehicles passing on the right on Eggerts Crossing Road heading towards Route 206 when the vehicles are trying to enter the Lawrence Intermediate School property when school is dismissing and vehicles are trying to turn left into school driveway. Chief Posluszny reported that he will look into this matter.
