MINUTES

Tuesday, December 9, 2014

Chief Wasko of the Lawrenceville Fire Company reported all apparatus in service at this time, although Telesquirt 23 will be out of service for 6 weeks for repairs. Jack Oakley reported 129-3 is out of service for a blown transmission, 129-4 has a heat problem and 129-2 has a block heater problem. 129-4 and 129-2 are still in service at this time waiting for repairs.
