

LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP COVID – 19 UPDATE

Lawrence Township – The Lawrence Township Health Department is reporting one additional cases of COVID–19 bringing the total number of cases reported in Lawrence Township to eight cases. Public health investigations are ongoing and possible contacts of the positive cases are being identified and contacted.

The public is advised to practice social distancing, avoid crowds and stay home when they are ill. Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer with a minimum of 60% alcohol. Practice good preventative measures including covering your coughs and sneezes using a tissue or sleeve. If you become ill, call your health care provider before visiting.
