- The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) regulates the transmission of natural gas pipelines. The Transco application has been accepted by FERC for filing (Docket number CP15-89-000) which formally starts the Federal review process. One may comment on the proposed pipeline and receive updates of information filed by Transco and other agencies or citizens. To do so, one must register with FERC online at <http://www.ferc.gov/docs-filing/eregistration.asp>
- In Lawrence Township, the Garden State Expansion Project includes the uprate of an existing electric motor drive and modifications of a compressor unit during Phase 1. Phase 2 will include uprate of two existing motor drives and replacement of associated compressor units. Transco has already received FERC approval to uprate two existing motors from 9500 horsepower to 10500 horsepower under the Leidy Southeast Project. The Garden State Expansion Project would further increase horsepower as noted below:

Phase 1: Increase one motor to 25000 horsepower, target in-service date November 2016
Phase 2: Increase two motors to 16000 horsepower each, target in-service date August 2017
