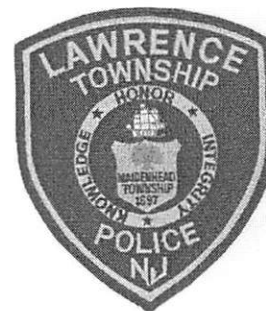

Dear Lawrence Township Resident:

In order to provide safe passage to pedestrian traffic in Lawrence Township, the Township currently has a snow removal ordinance in effect. The ordinance requires the owner, occupant or tenant, to remove all snow and ice from a sidewalk abutting their property within twenty-four hours from the end of snowfall. According to our records, the most recent snowfall ended at _____ am/pm on _____.

An inspection of your property was conducted and the sidewalks were found to be snow covered. A follow-up inspection will be conducted at the end of the twenty-four hour period and if the sidewalks have not been satisfactorily cleared, a municipal summons may be issued for this violation. If a summons is issued, the sidewalks will be re-inspected for compliance. Failure to clean the sidewalks after that time, may result in an additional summons being issued.

For your information and review, we are providing the specific ordinance language on snow removal.

Sec. 21-18. Snow and ice-Removal by property owner, occupant, etc.

The owner, occupant or tenant of premises abutting or bordering upon the sidewalk or corner of any street in the township shall remove all snow and ice from such sidewalks and through such corner to the width of not less than twenty-four inches, or in the case of ice, which may be so frozen as to make removal impracticable, shall cause the same to be thoroughly covered with sand or ashes, within twenty four hours after the same shall cease to fall or be formed thereon.
