Positive COVID-19 Cases in Lawrence Township

Yesterday the Lawrence Township Health Department was notified that two members of a family, who reside in our community and have been under home quarantine, tested positive for COVID-19.

The Health Department has conducted interviews with the individuals who tested positive to identify close contacts who are at elevated risk of potential exposure. These at-risk individuals are being contacted by the Health Department to advise them about precautions to take to prevent the spread of the virus. These individuals will be asked to monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19 for fourteen days from the date of their last exposure to the positive cases.

We ask that residents take preventative measures to reduce the spread of the virus in the community and included the following:

- Avoid crowds
- Stay home when you are sick
- Maintain a distance of six feet from others
- Wash your hands frequently
