“New Jersey Tree Recovery Campaign Provides Free Tree Seedlings to Residents in Lawrence Township”

Lawrence Township, NJ (April 4, 2019) – Free tree seedlings will be available to area residents as part of the New Jersey Tree Recovery Campaign. This program helps communities replace trees damaged or destroyed by Superstorm Sandy.

Residents will be able to pick up the seedlings at the Planning Office in the Lawrence Township Municipal Building at 2207 Lawrenceville Road from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM starting at noon on Friday, April 5. The seedlings, available on a first come, first served basis, come with instructions on how to store, care for, and plant them. Residents should plant the seedlings within two days after pick-up in order to prevent the roots from drying out.

The goal of the Tree Recovery Campaign is to distribute over 500,000 tree seedlings to New Jersey residents over the course of the next six years.

When properly planted and maintained, trees can be assets to a community. They improve the visual appeal of a neighborhood or business district, increase property values, reduce home cooling costs, remove air pollutants, and provide wildlife habitat, among many other benefits.
