

Q: WHY ANOTHER GARBAGE CONTAINER?

A: The township discovered that 20-30% of non-recycled trash is organic material – things like food, used paper products, weeds, anything that once lived. Let's recycle this instead!

Q: WHAT HAPPENS TO THE CONTENTS OF THIS GARBAGE CONTAINER?

A: All "curbside organics" will be taken to a special facility by Central Jersey Waste on a weekly basis and turned into usable soil! By acquiring one of these containers you will:

- Remove 20-30% of the trash, keeping it out of the landfills;
- Help create soil usable in our gardens and on our farms, which we are losing at record rates; and
- Decrease much of the methane gas produced when the organic waste decays over time.

Q: HOW DO I GET MY CONTAINER?

A: Register for this VOLUNTARY program right now by going to the township website: lawrencetwp.com. **WE NEED 300 PEOPLE TO SIGN UP BEFORE THE PROGRAM CAN BEGIN!**

Q: DOES IT COST MONEY TO GET MY CONTAINER?

A: There is a \$17/month fee. The first 300 people that register will receive a 30% discount for the first year of the program – that's a \$60 savings! We fully expect to reach 300 by the end of June so register NOW!

You have the option to share a container with a neighbor to help defray the cost. We include a small kitchen container and a starter supply of biodegradable bags. See the following pages for a list of everything you can put in your new container.

Q: ONCE I SIGN UP WITH THE TOWNSHIP, THEN WHAT?

A: Once we have 300 people registered, the Township will contact you to confirm your interest. Central Jersey Waste will bill you directly. The Township receives no money for implementing this program.
