

**Bakers Basin Road Bridge
Construction Project
Mercer County Department of Transportation**

Please be advised that on or about Wednesday, December 20, 2017, Public Service Electric and Gas will be completing utility relocation work in advance of the subject bridge replacement project. PSE&G's work will require closure of the north side of Bakers Basin Road between the Wawa/McDonald's access driveway and Shinney Lane in Lawrence Township. PSE&G anticipates that this work will take approximately four (4) weeks to complete, weather permitting, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

During construction, westbound traffic on Bakers Basin Road will be maintained. Eastbound motorists will be directed to use US Route 1 North to Grovers Mill Road; to Quakerbridge Road; to Lawrence Station Road. Basin Road will be fully open to traffic after 3:00 p.m. Mercer County staff will post signs prior to the start date advising motorists of the upcoming bridge work.

This project is being completed by the Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure and is consistent with our ongoing efforts to improve our roadways and structures.
