



Sustainable Jersey™ Certified Community

Lawrence Township is a [Sustainable Jersey](#) certified community--one of only 67 in the state. Lawrence Township first achieved Sustainable Jersey certification in 2009 and again was certified at the bronze level in 2010. Certified towns are widely recognized as an elite group of municipalities that are making important contributions toward the long-term goal of a sustainable New Jersey and world.

To become Sustainable Jersey certified, Lawrence Township had to complete a balance of the rigorous program sustainability [actions](#). In addition, Lawrence Township created a Green Team and did five priority actions by completing: 1) energy audits for municipal buildings, 2) a municipal carbon footprint, 3) a sustainable land use pledge, 4) a natural resource inventory and 5) a fleet inventory. Sustainable Jersey is a voluntary program that requires no fee for the certification.
