General Overview

The Township Planning Board is preparing a new Master Plan. The last comprehensive Master Plan, adopted in 1995, will be replaced by a new Master Plan that includes Goals and Objectives, Land Use Element (including hazard and climate change mitigation), Circulation Element, Conservation Element, Economic Development Element, and a Green Buildings and Sustainability Element. Adopted by the Planning Board, the Master Plan sets forth a vision for the community in the coming years and is the principal document that addresses the manner in which development, redevelopment, conservation and/or preservation should occur in Lawrence. It is intended to guide the decisions made by public officials and those of private interests involving the use of land.
