

#### Lawrence Joins Regional Effort to Transform Trenton Water Works

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has recommended creating a new independent public utility to operate Trenton Water Works (TWW), prompting a unified response from Lawrence Township and neighboring municipalities. The proposed restructuring comes after a comprehensive technical, managerial, and financial assessment of TWW revealed significant operational challenges.

The transformation is particularly significant for Lawrence Township residents, as our community is among the 55% of TWW customers who reside outside Trenton but currently have no formal role in TWW's governance or operations. Under the proposed changes, a new independent utility entity would be created to ensure more equitable representation and improved service delivery across all served municipalities.

Key priorities for the new entity include:

- Transparent appraisal of the creation process
- Clear assessment of impact on rates and fees
- Significant infrastructure improvements
- Professional staffing with competitive salaries

Mayor Hendricks Farmer, along with mayors from Hamilton, Ewing, and Hopewell Townships and the City of Trenton, has committed to working together over the next six months to establish this new utility entity. The goal is to create a more efficient, professionally managed water system that better serves all communities while ensuring long-term sustainability.


Residents will receive regular updates as this transition progresses. The Township Council remains committed to protecting our community's interests throughout this process.

# **ATTENTION!**

## LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP DOG OWNERS

It is NJ State law, as well as a Lawrence Township ordinance that ALL dogs 7 months and older must be licensed . Dog licenses must be renewed each year. A dog cannot be licensed unless it is properly vaccinated. Residents should be aware that if their dog is off a leash in public areas a court summons may be issued, except on their private property or at one of the (2) dog parks in Lawrence Township. Retractable leashes or leashes longer than six (6) feet in length are not acceptable leashes to use while in public.

A license tag helps police, animal control, and shelters quickly identify your pet and get them back to you safely. If your pet is found wandering the streets, a rescue entity can see your pets tag via its license ID number. Dogs that are not licensed tend to be kept at the shelter longer and also require payment to be released.
