What is the Citizens Police Academy?

The Citizens Police Academy is an 8-week program designed to give participants an understanding of the operation of the Lawrence Township Police Department and a working knowledge of what law enforcement entails. The classes are held once a week and are approximately 2-2.5 hours. The classes will be limited to 20 students, so register early! There is no cost for residents to participate. Participants will also receive a Citizens Police Academy polo shirt to wear to class.

Each class will provide an overview of various areas of law enforcement. The following topics will be taught during the classes:

Several demonstrations will take place during the academy, in which attendees will be allowed to participate and simulate taking police actions.

Upon completion of the academy, each participant will receive a certificate of completion at graduation.

Attendance

You are expected to attend ALL sessions in order to graduate. If you have more than two absences, you may not be allowed to graduate. Out of curtesy to the instructors and your fellow students, please arrive on time.

Why Participate?

This academy provides an opportunity for citizens to develop a working knowledge of the police department and its functions. It is hoped that the instruction will strengthen the policecommunity relations through an educational process.

Who Can Attend?

Participants must be at least 21 years of age and reside or work in Lawrence Twp. They must be of good moral character. A background investigation will be conducted on each applicant prior to acceptance into the academy. An application for the academy must be completed and signed along with a waiver of liability. You will be notified if/ when you are accepted into the academy.

What the Academy is Not

The academy is *not* designed to make participants certified police officers nor give authority to take law enforcement action. Your participation and completion of the academy is designed to develop partnerships within the community. Graduating from the academy does *not* grant police authority to participants.
